COVID-19 Privacy Notice

Canterbury Baptist Church Privacy Notice for collecting contact information from church attendees.

This privacy notice is an addendum to Canterbury Baptist Church's main privacy statement and notices. The Charity Trustees of Canterbury Baptist Church (as Data Controller) can be contacted by ringing 01227 456204 or emailing office@canterburybaptistchurch.org.uk

We are collecting your name and contact details in order to fulfil our responsibility to provide a safe environment in which those attending Canterbury Baptist Church can pray and worship during this COVID-19 recovery phase.

We will only use this information to contact you in the event that we believe you may have come into contact with a suspected case of COVID-19 at Canterbury Baptist Church and it may be necessary to share your details with NHS Test and Trace if they are requested for contact tracing and the investigation of local outbreaks.

Your name and contact details will temporarily be securely stored and retained for a period of 21 days in line with government guidance and then disposed of within the following 7 days.

Please inform Canterbury Baptist Church as soon as possible if you test positive for COVID-19 or develop any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- A fever
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Data Protection legislation allows us to process this information as we regard it as being in the church's legitimate interest.
